ORDINANCE NO. 2017-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLARKSVILLE, TEXAS CALLING AN ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 6, 2017 TO ELECT FOUR COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR A TWO-YEAR TERM; PROVIDING FOR EARLY VOTING AND FOR NOTICE OF THE ELECTION; AND FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATING TO THE ELECTION. THE CITY COUNCIL IN AND FOR THE CITY OF CLARKSVILLE, TEXAS ALSO AUTHORIZES A JOINT ELECTION TO BE HELD WITH THE CLARKSVILLE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT (CISD) AT THE CITY HALL, 800 WEST MAIN STREET, CLARKSVILLE, TEXAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARKSVILLE, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of Clarksville, Texas with the concurrence of the City Council, orders an election to be held on May 6, 2017, for the purpose of electing four council members for a two year term to Wards I, II, III & IV.

Section 2. The Mayor of the City of Clarksville, Texas with the concurrence of the City Council, further authorizes a joint election to be held with the Clarksville Independent School District (CISD).

Section 3. The polling place in the City of Clarksville is at City Hall, 800 West Main Street, Clarksville, Texas.

Section 4. That the City Manager Acting as City Secretary shall receive applications by mail for a ballot to be voted by mail from March 7, 2017 until the close of business April 25, 2017. Requests for applications should be mailed to:

Section 5. That the dates and times for early voting by personal appearance shall be as follows for the following location:



Tuesday, May 2, 2017 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Section 6. That the notice of the election shall be given as provided by law.

Section 7. That voting at the election, including early voting, shall be by use of paper ballots and the eSlate Voting System, which has been duly approved by the Secretary of State.
