

The City of Clarksville, Texas is seeking to enter into an engineering services contract with a Texas registered engineering firm. The following outlines the request for qualifications.

Scope of Work

The City of Clarksville has an aging water system that requires extensive reconstruction. Following are some of the items needed:

- Repair or replace leaking lines,
- Meter replacements,
- SCADA system to connect wells, pumps and water storage facilities,
- Possible new well, and
- Explore/apply for grants and or loans for system repairs.

Statement of Qualifications

Please submit your firm qualifications, a list of projects completed within the past five (5) to ten (10) years of a similar nature with contact information for those clients, a copy of your current certificate of insurance for professional liability and a list of the staff that would be assigned to the project. Clarksville needs firms experienced in the preparation of reports and applications such as required by the Texas Water Development Board, USDA Rural Development and other state/federal agencies providing assistance with water system improvements. SOQs should be 12 pages or less.

Evaluation Criteria

The proposals will be ranked according to the following criteria, with the number being the maximum points allowed per category.

- Experience 50
- Knowledge of Clarksville issues 10
- Work performance 25
- Capacity to perform 15

Respondent's qualifications will be evaluated and the most qualified respondent will be selected subject to negotiation of fair and reasonable compensation.
