

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARKSVILLE, TEXAS, DECLARING CERTAIN FIRE AIR PACKS AS SURPLUS; PROVIDING FOR THE AUTHORIZATION TO DONATE SAID PROPERTY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, personal property is exempt from bidding procedures under Texas Local Government Code Section 252.022(a)(12)(C); and

WHEREAS, the City of Clarksville, Texas (the "City") has the authority to dispose of "salvage property" or "surplus property" under state law, including but not limited to, Texas Local Government Code Chapter 51; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the City is in possession of personal property, specifically several air packs, that are considered under state law to be "surplus property" because they are no longer used and of little or no value to the City, and such property is more particularly described in "Exhibit A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, this surplus property has no or minimal value for an attempted sale; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to donate the air packs to the City of Annona, a neighboring volunteer fire department agency that is within the mutual aid service area of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Engine would serve the City of Annona area and the City in times of activation by mutual aid agreements; and

WHEREAS, the donation of the air packs would serve a legitimate public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARKSVILLE, TEXAS:

Section 1. The findings recited above are incorporated as if fully set forth in the body of this Resolution and are adopted as the legislative findings of the City Council.


Section 2. The air packs described in "Exhibit A" to this Resolution are hereby declared surplus property.

Section 3. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute any documents required for the transfer of ownership of the air packs listed in "Exhibit A" to the City of Annona Volunteer Fire Department and to secure a release from said volunteer fire department.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
